MINUTES

The regular meeting of the Upshur County Emergency Services District No. 2 Commissioners was held on February 21, 2023, at the Ore City Fire Station, 102 S. Dogwood, Ore City, Texas 75683.

- 3) <u>Determine quorum present</u>. Gaston DeBerry, III determined a quorum with Tommie Whitaker, Trevor Larrington, and Kenny Hankins being present. Gregg Price was absent.
